What: Air Force Public Scoping Meetings

The Department of the Air Force (DAF) proposes to recapitalize the T-38C Talon flight training program at Sheppard AFB with T-7A Red Hawk aircraft. This proposal supports the Secretary of the Air Force's strategic basing decisions to recapitalize existing T-38C pilot training installations, and Sheppard AFB would be the fifth installation to be analyzed for possible recapitalization.
